

AP Music Royalties Fund acquires producer rights catalogue of Tom Allom

AP Music Royalties Fund (APMRF), a fully regulated Liechtenstein Alternative Investment Fund, has acquired the producer rights catalogue of English record producer Tom Allom.

Tom Allom is best known as the producer of various successful heavy metal albums spanning from the 1970s into the 1990s. The catalogue acquired comprises of several legendary heavy metal bands such as Judas Priest (e.g. Breaking the Law, Living after Midnight, You've Got Another Thing Coming), Def Leppard (e.g. Rock Brigade, Wasted) and Krokus (e.g. Screaming in the Night). Tom Allom was represented in the transaction by his long-time business manager Mike Dolan of Metro Associates.

Darren Michaelson, Music Manager of APMRF: "Songs like "Breaking the Law" and "Living after Midnight" defined the metal scene in the late 1970s and early 1980s and Judas Priest was instrumental in creating the new wave of British heavy metal. Heavy metal as a genre has a very loyal and stable fanbase that treasures legendary songs and bands from the past. This is the second larger investment of APMRF into this solid genre, after the acquisition of the Dave Fortman (Slipknot) producer catalogue. It adds stability and diversification to our fund and further underlines our strong ability in sourcing attractive and well-established music catalogues."
