Bill Padley is a Scottish award-winning songwriter and music producer. He is best known for co-writing the bestselling UK single of 2005, "That's My Goal" (2005), by X-Factor winner Shayne Ward, and "Whole Again" (2000) by Atomic Kitten, which remains the best-selling song of the 21st century in the UK by a girl group. Other notable songs written by Bill Padley include "Best In Me" (2001) as recorded by the boy band Blue and "The Tide Is High" (2001) as recorded by Atomic Kitten. Bill Padley was represented in the transaction by Mike Dolan & Lloyd Beiny of Metro Associates.
