Terence Lam is a Canadian songwriter, audio engineer and music producer. He is best known for co-writing the hit singles “Here” by Alessia Cara, and “Too Good” by Drake and Rihanna. With c. 80 million monthly Spotify listeners each, Rihanna and Drake are among the most streamed artists globally. Terence Lam has additionally contributed writing credits on several hits in Canada, including “Gravity” by Ralph, which was a top 20 hit domestically and received a JUNO nomination for Dance Recording of the Year in 2020.
